When I hesitantly opened up my Messenger to read the unsolicited text, I saw that it was from a woman named Vika Sychova, which didn't ring a bell. I glanced at her profile picture associated with her account, and I still didn't recognize her. I will not edit her message but will paste it here in its entirety:

"Hello Mr. Horn, you may not remember me, but you led me to Christ. Your and Natasha prayed with me my prayer of repentance. I met your wife too; she was pregnant with her first baby at that time. Thankful to God for sending you, guys, all the way to Khabarovsk so I could exchange the curse of sin for eternity."

I do not remember Vika Sychova, but I must have shared Christ with her in Russia in 1993. This past year, God blessed me by allowing me to hear about how those seeds planted 26 years ago had grown roots, sprouted, and produced fruit. It also gave me hope that there are more stories like Vika's out there. There are more times that seeds have been planted but the fruit has not yet been seen by me, or by you. Let us live this year with the hope that every testimony we give, every gospel presentation we are able to share, no matter how short, is a potential story like Vika's. May we all be faithful to take every opportunity to share the Good News of Jesus Christ and trust the fruit to God!
